MOVEMBER AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

Awareness for male health...!!

"Movember is the leading charity changing the face of men's health on a global scale, focusing on mental health and suicide prevention, prostate cancer and testicular cancer."

It is still a taboo topic to discuss about men's health especially concerning testicular and prostate cancer in Nepal and other developing countries. Men's health issues – prostate cancer, testicular cancer or even men's mental health issues have long been an ignored topic. As these problems normally arise in adult of age more than 50 years old and used to be primarily seen in men's of west, it wasn't considered vital. But things are changing, men in Nepalese society have been seen a rising cases of these diseases. With this thought in mind, RT Nepal took the initiative of "Movember – men's health awareness" to invite corporates and create a platform to discuss about these topics. Our very first session was organized in year 2019 and now in 2022, RT Nepal has successfully conducted more than 15 sessions with more than 550 participants in 8 different cities in Nepal. These sessions were led by doctors and were organized at different corporate offices.

Why Movember? "Movember is an annual event involving the growing of moustaches during the month of November to raise awareness of men's health issues such as prostate cancer, testicular cancer and men's suicide. This movement is run by Movember charity event and is aimed to change the face of men's health. By encouraging men to get involved, Movember aims to increase early cancer detection, diagnosis and effective treatments."

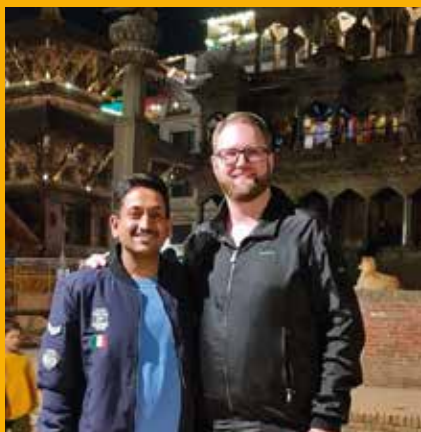
